Dear Parishioners,

We examine our conscience—before the Lord—in our hearts—perhaps even before a crucifix, to remember the greatness of God's love—and what Jesus paid for our salvation. Sin boils down to selfishness.

The scripture below are excerpts from Isaiah chapter 53, which we hear on Good Friday, clearly describes what it cost for the forgiveness of our sins.

"See, my servant shall prosper,

he shall be raised high and greatly exalted.

Yet it was our infirmities that he bore,

our sufferings that he endured,

while we thought of him as stricken,

as one smitten by God and afflicted.

But he was pierced for our offenses,

crushed for our sins;

upon him was the chastisement that makes us whole,

the guilt of us all.

Though he was harshly treated, he submitted

and opened not his mouth;

and who would have thought any more of his destiny?

When he was cut off from the land of the living,

and smitten for the sin of his people,

a grave was assigned him among the wicked

and a burial place with evildoers,

though he had done no wrong

nor spoken any falsehood.

But the LORD was pleased

to crush him in infirmity.

Because of his affliction

he shall see the light in fullness of days;

through his suffering, my servant shall justify many,

and their guilt he shall bear. "

With gratitude for such love, we humbly confess that we are sinners! Christ welcomes sinners!

There will be a Communal Penance Service on Palm Sunday, April 10th, 2:00 pm at St. Mary's Church with three priests to hear confessions. Please take this opportunity to experience God's extravagant healing love and mercy.

Please continue to pray for those who are suffering in Ukraine, for the brave soldiers and citizens who are defending their people, for a change of heart by President Putin, for those we left behind in Afghanistan, and those whose lives are touched by the Pandemic.

You are in my daily prayers, please pray for me.
