Father's Corner

...OUR FATHER

This Sunday's Gospel tells us about Jesus who prays alone, away in a quiet place. "When he had finished, says the Gospel, one of his disciples asked him: Lord, teach us to pray as John the Baptist taught his disciples."

And he answered: "When you pray, say: Father."

Father! Yes, this word is the secret of Jesus' prayer. It is the key that he himself gives us. This is how we too can pray and be able to enter into a confidential dialogue with the Father who accompanied Him throughout his life.

The first petitions tell us that we should be concerned with God's reign, God's glory and God's will. We are invited to give God his full and central place in our life. He asks only to exercise his lordship of love there. It is in our lives that the holiness of God must be apparent, visible. Through these requests, we express our gratitude to the Father who fills us with his love.

Three other requests complete this prayer that Jesus teaches us. These three requests concern bread, forgiveness and help in temptations. This is absolutely important because one cannot live without bread; one cannot live without forgiveness or without God's help in temptations. But we are to remember that the most essential bread is that of the Eucharist. As Christians, we must wish to always feed on this Divine bread to be transformed by Christ. It is there that our celestial Father gives us the light and the strength of his grace.

Holy Mass will follow at 5:00 pm.








