### **Father's Corner**

#### Rich only in what matters to God

As human beings, we hunger to be satisfied. But since our hunger knows no boundaries, we naturally yearn to possess more and always more. We are satisfied with the latest smartphone model or the wide-screen TV until a newer model with more features appears. And again, is anyone satisfied with his or her salary? No one for sure. So it seems that the more we have, the more we want to have.

Jesus teaches us that we already have more than we can imagine: the fullness of life that God offers to those who trust in him.

And that's why in the Gospel, Jesus seems perturbed at the question about inheritance put to him by someone in the crowd. Jesus is not the judge or arbitrator of such earthly matters, what the 1<sup>st</sup> reading calls "vanity". He is rather the judge and arbitrator of what matters most to God: lasting happiness and the fullness of life in God.

Many of us are so caught up in the things and demands of daily living that it is hard for us to assess where our focus actually lies. We need to reflect on what we say matters the most to us and what our manner of living says matters most to us. Therefore we need to reflect on what Jesus says matters most and what God is offering us.
