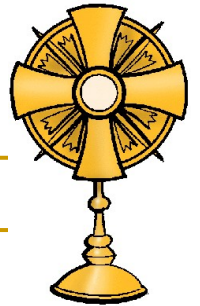
# Father's Corner

God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.

We will never forget our first love. Because the experience was new, and these feelings never felt before changed us forever. Although this first relationship often does not last, the memory lingers in our minds as a gift for life.

The Gospel reveals something amazing this Sunday: that the world (each of us!) is God's first love. And God never forgets us, but loves us into eternal Life. God's great love for the world is expressed in God's greatest gift: "he gave his only Son." This only Son is the risen One who sends the Spirit to dwell within us and bind us in communion with our Trinitarian God and one another as we hear in the second reading of this Sunday.

Yes, this triune God (Father, Son, Spirit) chooses to be one with us, loving us into eternal Life. God's gift of love is given to each of us who choose to believe. This divine love calls us to love others without reserve, to draw near to the other, to give ourselves graciously for the well-being of others. In daily living our love might be expressed by reaching out to the lonely and depressed among us, saying a kind word to the discouraged, treating strangers with respect. Love begets love. And our triune God never forgets.

### What is the Liturgy of the Eucharist?

The Liturgy of the Eucharist is the second and the most significant part of Holy Mass. Christ Himself instituted it at the Last Supper so He could be continuously present in His Church until the end of time.

The Liturgy of the Eucharist includes the 1. preparation of gifts, where the bread and wine with water are brought to the altar 2. the Eucharistic prayer, giving thanks to God for the whole work of salvation, and 3. the consecration, where the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ. The breaking of the one bread in preparation for the faithful receiving the Lord's Body and Blood, just as the apostles received It at the Last Supper from Jesus' own Hands.
