FATHER'S COLUMN

Jesus put his finger into the man's ears and, spitting, touched his tongue; then he looked up to heaven and groaned, and said to him, "Ephphatha!", that is, "Be opened!"

Many of our behaviors indicate the ways we are closed: stubbornness, fixations, tunnel vision, selective hearing, prejudices. Other behaviors indicate the ways we are open: curiosity, creativity, conversing, risk taking, changing. Remaining closed cuts us off from fuller life; becoming more open enriches our life.

Jesus is the One who opens us to receive the healing and fullness of life God offers us. Whatever within us is closed to the presence and saving acts of God, Jesus comes to open. Only through his healing touch do we receive salvation and become able to proclaim this Good News to all we meet.

The Gospel notes that Jesus took the man "away from the crowd" to heal him. Many times what keeps us from encountering Jesus is the "crowd" of overly busy lives; of too much noise from TV, advertising, iPhones, empty conversations; of being too caught up in what everyone else is saying and doing. This Sunday's Gospel urges us to become more aware of whatever keeps us from encountering Jesus and hearing his command, "Be opened!"
