## FATHER'S COLUMN

This solemnity of Peter; Apostle to the Jews, and Paul ; Apostle to the Gentiles, celebrates both historical figures and their symbolic roles as representatives of the Church.

If we would perceive this solemnity as about individuals, we might think that Paul comes up short, since two readings, the first reading and the Gospel, focus on Peter and only the second reading tells of Paul.

However, this festival is really one celebrating the Church rather than two individuals as such. These two great apostles represent for us a Church in communion with Christ continuing his saving work.

In the gospel of this feast, in response to Jesus' question about who he is, Peter names him as "the Christ, the Son of the living God." In turn, Jesus names Peter as the "rock" upon which the Church will be built. Like Peter, we must come to know who Jesus is and who we are in relation to him if, like Paul, we are to finish the race, keep the faith, and receive the crown of life as stated in the second reading. Thus, we can only carry forth Jesus' saving mission if we know who Jesus is. Also, only by knowing who Jesus is can we come to salvation.

Peter and Paul are both models for us followers of Jesus who knew intimately their Lord and Master. Neither Peter nor Paul lived for themselves once they encountered Jesus and knew who he was: the Savior of the world.

The grace to identify Christ always circles back and creates our own identity in relation to Christ. Now we spend our lives learning about who Christ is and how to find Christ in all the circumstances of our lives. We come to know Christ and realize that we are his presence in our world. This is what it means to be Church! The Church is neither building nor empty space; Church is Christ's body carrying on his saving work. May Sts Peter and Paul intercede for us.
